





GUIDELINES FOR PODIUM PRESENTATIONS

19th May 2021

Before the conference (DEADLINE June 7, 2021)

1. Prepare a pre-recorded presentation using the template available on the conference website [File name CDIO2021 PresentationTemplate.pptx].

EER Track – maximum 10 minutes

Advances in CDIO and CDIO Implementation Tracks – maximum 7 minutes

Project-in-progress Track – maximum 5 minutes

- 2. No limit for number of slides, however, your pre-recorded presentation should not exceed the time limit.
- 3. To maximize audience's understanding and participation to your valuable work, speakers from non-native English speaking countries could use close-caption or dubbing from native English speakers.
- 4. Export your record into a video [name your file: submissionID Presentation.mp4]
- 5. Upload your video to YouTube with following set up

a. Details/Title submissionID_Presentation

b. Details/Description Paper titlec. Visibility Unlisted

6. Send YouTube link to CDIO2021@chula.ac.th

TOPIC: submissionID_Presentation YouTube Link

- 7. Upload your video file submissionID_Presentation.mp4 to https://bit.ly/3eYTkPn
- 8. All pre-recorded presentations should be sent to the organizer no later than June 7, 2021.
- 9. The YouTube link will be posted and available to watch before the conference starts.

During the conference

- 1. Join the Zoom link at least 5 minutes before the session begins.
- 2. Please follow any instructions given to you by the session chair. The chair will be responsible for introducing each session, facilitating questions and answers (Q&A) discussions, and keeping the presentations strictly on schedule.
- 3. The pre-record presentation will be played for each paper, followed by questions and answers (Q&A).
- 4. Audiences will be invited to submit questions or comments in the chat box during the presentation.
- 5. The session encourages a discussion among the speakers and the attendees regarding the session topic synchronously. Due to the nature of scheduling parallel tracks, potential conflicts with other sessions will likely have an effect on the size of the audience.









How to Upload YouTube


- 1. Log in to your YouTube account.
- 2. Click on the video icon at the top right hand side of the window, which can be found next to your user icon, messages, apps, and notifications.
- 3. Click 'Upload Video.
- 4. Then, press 'select files to **upload**' to find the video file [submissionID_Presentation.mp4] saved on your computer.



5. Your submissionID Presentation should be shown in Details window (see below)



6. Key in your paper Title in the Details > Description box (see below)










7. At the last step Visibility > Save or publish, select Unlisted (see below)
